## TRUST WELCOMES ROBERT A. KINSLEY, II TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

*York, PA, January 28, 2010:* The York County Heritage Trust announces the appointment of Robert A. Kinsley, II, AIA to its Board of Directors. As the president of LSC Design, Kinsley is responsible for overseeing the firm's design work and serves as coordinator on many of its larger projects, which include the development of a 140,000-square-foot museum and visitors center on a 100-acre site at the Gettysburg National Battlefield Park. Under his leadership, LSC's net revenues have grown by 38 percent while gross revenues have grown by 60 percent.

As one of five sons in a York County construction family, he has witnessed and participated in the phenomenal growth of his father's firm, Kinsley Construction Inc. Having worked in a field with many trades, Kinsley built on this experience and turned to building designs. As president of LSC Architectural one of Kinsley's primary goals has been to transform LSC from a company geared towards serving a limited clientele to one that serves a broader client base.

The York County Heritage Trust is a not-for-profit educational institution that preserves and uses its collections, historic sites and museums to inspire people to explore the history and culture of York County, Pennsylvania.
